Address	Monash University, Clayton VIC 3800 (campus entry via Wellington Road) For Navigation: SW1 Carpark, Monash University Clayton Campus, 38 Innovation Walk, Clayton VIC 3168
Landmark	Just north of the Clayton Bus Interchange, along Innovation Walk. A short walk from the Learning & Teaching Building (LTB).

ABOUT THE VENUE

The exam is held at the Monash College Learning Village (building CL_33), at 33 Innovation Walk. It is a cluster of low-rise buildings connected by walkways, with its entrance directly off Innovation Walk. Your child's exam is in Room G101, a ground-floor tutorial room.

Innovation Walk is a central pedestrian path on campus. It runs north from Ancora Imparo Way, right next to the Clayton Bus Interchange and close to the Learning & Teaching Building (LTB). Whichever way you arrive, the Bus Interchange is the easiest landmark to aim for, then it is a short walk up Innovation Walk to CL_33.

HOW TO GET THERE

 TRAIN + BUS	
Recommended · Train to Huntingdale, then 601 shuttle	
1	Catch any train on the Pakenham or Cranbourne line from Flinders Street or any City Loop station.
2	Alight at Huntingdale Station.
3	Board the 601 shuttle bus from the station forecourt. It runs every few minutes directly to Clayton Campus and terminates at the Clayton Bus Interchange on Ancora Imparo Way.
4	From the Bus Interchange, walk north onto Innovation Walk (the pedestrian path beside the bus loop). Follow it a short distance to the Monash College Learning Village, CL_33. JT staff will be at the entrance from 10:00 AM to point you to Room G101.
<i>Tip: You need a Myki card for all Melbourne public transport. Top up at the station or online before you travel.</i>	

 BY CAR	
Park or drop off at SW1, right next to the venue	
1	Enter the campus from Wellington Road, Clayton, at the main southern entrance.
2	Head for the SW1 (South-West One) car park at 38 Innovation Walk. This is the closest car park to the venue, just metres from CL_33.

3	You can either drop your child off right outside SW1 or park there and walk in together. Parking is free on weekends, so no ticket is needed on Sunday.
4	From SW1, the Monash College Learning Village (CL_33) is a short walk along Innovation Walk. Head to Room G101 inside. JT staff will be at the entrance from 10:00 AM.

Tip: Set your maps app to 'SW1 Car Park, 38 Innovation Walk' for the most direct drive in. Parking is FREE on weekends.

BUS ONLY

Many routes stop at the Clayton Bus Interchange

1	Routes 601, 630, 703, 733, 737, 802, 804, 862 and SmartBus 900 all stop at the Clayton Bus Interchange on Ancora Imparo Way.
2	Alight at the Bus Interchange (the main bus loop in front of the Learning & Teaching Building).
3	Walk north onto Innovation Walk and follow it a short distance to the Monash College Learning Village, CL_33. Head to Room G101 inside.

Tip: Check ptv.vic.gov.au for Sunday timetables, as some routes run less frequently on weekends. Allow extra time.

RIDESHARE OR TAXI

Uber, Didi, or taxi straight to campus

1	Set your destination to: SW1 Car Park, 38 Innovation Walk, Monash University Clayton. If the app does not recognise it, use the Clayton Bus Loop or 33 Innovation Walk.
2	Ask the driver to enter via Wellington Road and drop you at SW1 on Innovation Walk, right beside the venue.
3	From SW1, the Learning Village (CL_33) is just a short walk. Head to Room G101 inside.

Tip: Searching 'SW1 Car Park Monash' or 'Monash Clayton Bus Loop' gives the most reliable drop-off point.

ONCE YOU ARRIVE: FINDING ROOM G101

1. Make your way to the Clayton Bus Interchange on Ancora Imparo Way. This is the main bus loop in front of the Learning & Teaching Building (LTB), and is the easiest landmark to aim for from any direction.
2. From there, step onto Innovation Walk and follow it a short distance. If you arrived by car, the SW1 car park at 38 Innovation Walk is right beside the venue.
3. You will reach the Monash College Learning Village, signed CL_33, at 33 Innovation Walk. JT Education staff will be at the entrance from 10:00 AM.
4. Head inside to Room G101, a ground-floor tutorial room. Follow the JT team to the check-in desk.
5. Check in from 10:15 AM. Have your Humanitix booking QR code and photo ID ready.
6. Parents: drop off from 10:00 AM and return to the CL_33 entrance for collection between 2:05 and 2:30 PM.

ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO BRING

Please ensure your child brings the following, as no sharing is allowed during the exam:

Writing instruments: Two (2) pens with black or blue ink.

Identification: Student ID or any photo ID.

Pencils and accessories: Two or more HB pencils, a sharpener, and a rubber.

Case: A clear pencil case.

Water: A clear water bottle.

Phone: Students may keep their phone, but it must be completely powered off during the exam.

Food: A light snack for the break.

Restricted items: Rulers, calculators, and correction fluid (white-out) are NOT allowed in the examination room.
