Overview

The number 8.5 million is the estimated number of voters it would take to bring about change through nonviolent protest. This is based on the <u>following finding</u> from the Carr-Ryan Center for Human Rights:

"Nonviolent protests are twice as likely to succeed as armed conflicts...and those engaging a threshold of 3.5% of the population have never failed to bring about change."

According to the <u>University of Florida</u>, approximately 245 million Americans were eligible to vote in the 2024 general election. According to the above research, if 3.5% of



these eligible voters — 8,575,000 people — engage in nonviolent protests, we *will* bring about meaningful change.

Messaging

Topline

- 1. Our country is in a constitutional crisis:
- The League defines a Constitutional Crisis as: When the executive, the legislative, or judiciary branches cannot or will not adequately protect the US Constitution, when there are explicit attempts to dismantle a functional democracy within any of the three branches, or when any level of federal government takes action to destroy democratic institutions in a manner that intentionally or purposefully jeopardizes the US Constitution.
- 2. There are four pillars of Unite & Rise 8.5 from LWVUS:
 - Legal & Policy Advocacy: Challenge unconstitutional actions through litigation, advocate for electoral integrity reforms at state and federal levels, fight voter suppression, and protect due process.
 - Public Mobilization & Coalition Building: Turn out millions for quick activations and longer-planned activist campaigns, uplift local voices, and partner with grassroots, national, and international organizations.
 - Civic Education & Engagement: Launch public awareness campaigns, expand voter registration and turnout efforts, host educational forums, connect policy to real-life impact, and equip people with tools to act.
 - Democracy Resilience: Build lasting infrastructure to protect democratic values and institutions for the long haul.
- 3. LWVWI has four pillars as well, specific to our needs in Wisconsin:



Unite & Rise Wisconsin Pillars:

- 1. Defend democracy & reject authoritarianism
- 2. Empower people with their rights & stand united in solidarity
- 3. Standing up to protect human rights including:
 - a. **Protect voting rights**
 - b. End mass deportation and keep families together
 - c. Protect reproductive rights
 - d. Protect LGBTQ+ rights
- 4. Lay the foundation for a more just democracy in Wisconsin

Best Practices

- Messaging formula: Shared values (freedom to vote, unity) + problem (legislators who
 don't reflect our values/trying to erode voting rights/power-grab) + solution (standing
 together to vote no, keeping our state moving forward)
- Say what is true rather than refuting what is not. Don't give opposition claims any airtime. Don't repeat their hurtful and dehumanizing language.
- Avoid jargon and stay out of the weeds!
