Google Cast for Education Instructions

Google cast for education is an app that allows someone to share their screen with your computer. This would allow a teacher to walk around the classroom with their chromebook and share the chromebook screen with their desktop computer that is connected to their smartboard. Additionally, students could share their screens with the smartboard if the teacher allows access

Setup your teacher station to receive other screens

Download the App

 Go to the <u>chrome web store</u> and search for Google cast for education



- Next to the Google Cast for Education Result
- Click the blue button to Add to Chrome



- Log into the Chrome browser on your teacher station
- Click the waffle icon on your bookmarks bar to launch your chrome apps
 - o If the bookmarks bar is blank:
 - Click on the 3 lines in the upper right corner of chrome
 - Choose Bookmarks then Show Bookmarks Bar



Launch the app on your teacher station

- Scroll to find the Google Cast for Education app in your list of apps
- Google Cast for

Click the app to open Cast

Setup the app to receive casts

 Enter a Receiver name for your teacher station that will be used to display the other screens. I use either my classroom number or last name.




Keep both boxes checked and click save.



- Choose Cast from the list of options




