History  Make a model of a viking longboat! The Vikings were good at making boats. Think about including: how you got the new place, the weapons you used and the food you ate to aid your survival. 30 marks
Science Make a poster or write a story about how the world would be different if dinosaurs had not gone extinct. Ideas: Think about whether humans would have evolved or not, and how dinosaurs would have evolved over time too.
