Finswimming team Novi Jelkovec has been established in 2018 and it is based in Sesvete-Zagreb (Croatia). Its main activity is finswimming, especially competitions and sport trainings. Since 2018 Novi Jelkovec won several medals in Croatian national championship, for instance in individual races with Luka Sudarević (2018) or with its male relay in 2023. Their coach and tutor is Rubes Levada, who is

president of parent club Finswimming Team Komet also based in Croatia. The club now counts 15 members.

FT Novi Jelkovec is participating in a Small Cooperative Partnership co-financed by Erasmus+ Sport program, as partner: Project "Water Sports Festival" (ERASMUS-SPORT-2022-SSCP nr 101090924).

Due to the very local activity in a relatively new quarter of Zagreb, with a recently-built swimming pool, the Club plans to expand its activities in other water sports, especially the social dimension of these sports and physical activities: gender equality, activities for disabled people, attention to minorities and similar.

Please provide a short summary of the project outcomes and describe if and how the new proposal seeks to build on them.	
The projects "Aurora - Sport. School. Life." and its follow-up "Aurora Adriatic" aim to develop and promote a strong culture and ethics based on principles of good governance, and to implement those principles in everyday functioning of sport clubs in Europe. The project focus on education of athletes in the fields of nutrition, training and management. The project adopt a bottom-up concept in designing the learning process, and a learning-by-doing teaching approach. This innovative aspect translates into 3 main elements: localized introductory workshops, e-learning sessions as a core education activity and a traineeship in a sport organisation. Four sport clubs will take part in Aurora and in Aurora Adriatic, each of them brings into the project either a success story, a rich history and experience or the sheer enthusiasm of grassroots. There is a strong demand for this kind of projects with small not-professional clubs, due to basic lack of skills among clubs' managers who are usually volunteers without any professional background. The target groups are athletes and other club members, and indirectly other interested sport bodies. The project objectives include education of athletes and sport club members, development of their skills and knowledge in areas critical for sustainable development of sport clubs. Second objective is promotion of the concept and practices of good governance in sports in Europe, and the third is development of a stronger cooperation among related European sport clubs, in order to support the institutionalized exchange of experiences and knowledge. At the end of the project, the participants will be able to manage a sport club independently and replicate the results in any future situation. Additionally, the project will produce a web platform that will make available all e-learning material, applications, documents and solutions for routine tasks of a non-professional sport club. Aurora is the name of the project, as it recalls the dawn. The dawn of a new culture in sport, school, life. Through project Aurora website it's possible to access all e-learning material so far produced, which is to be implemented, and the connected literature and attachments. There's also an expertise accumulated by FT Komet in running this kind of education and workshops. All this material and knowledge is the starting point for this project, which is actually a step forward: it's time to apply principles to everyday functioning and develop a common way to work it. Projects Aurora, among others goals, has to generate a "spill-over" effect to other sport organisations. Actually the current project targets other clubs and countries where it will be easier to run it if it will be possible to build upon accumulated "treasure" from Aurora project.
