

FAGAN HASANLI

Fagan Hasanli was born in Azerbaijan, Baku in 1990. He has graduated from The Hajibeyov Baku Academy of Music with a BA and an MA (hons) in the class of professor, honored Artist of the Azerbaijan Republic, T. Seyidov. He has won “Gran-pri” in competition between music schools of Baku in 2006. He was a laureate and the 1st place winner in the “Hopes, Talents, Masters” International Competition in Dobrich, Bulgaria, in 2010 and in the International Scientific and Performing G.Garayev competition in Baku. He participated in III international competition named after Vaja Chachava, which was held in Georgia, Tbilisi in 2019 and won first prize. He has participated in the master classes given by pianists like F.Badalbeyli, O. Yablonskaya, A.Bonduryansky, V.Chuchkov and has played concerts at the same stage with such conductors as maestro R.Abdullayev, A.Aliyev, T.Goychayev and F.Ibrahimov both as a soloist and within the orchestra at the local and international scenes. He has been the first performer of Gara Garaev’s “Three-Voice Fugue” and Jahangir Garayev’s “Sonata”.

He has been a laureate of the “Youth Award”. In recent years, he has been awarded with diplomas and certificates of honor for his active works in the field of music, by the Ministry of Education, Ministry of Youth and Sports and the Free Trade Union.

Currently, he is working as a teacher (music studio) and a concertmaster in Baku Academy of Music and Secondary Music School named after Bulbul. He is also an orchestra artist at Azerbaijan State Academic Opera and Ballet Theatre. In addition to being an active participant in a number of international festivals, F.Hasanli continues his own solo concert performing. He gave recitals in Russia (Bashkortostan Republic), participated in different festivals and conferences in Moscow and Novosibirsk. As soloist and concertmaster he participated in concerts which held in Israel, USA, Ukraine, Estonia, Georgia, Uzbekistan, Turkey, Kazakhstan and so on. In 2019 he played with Yefim Bronfman within the 10th M.Rostropovich international festival.
