- Given the city's current budget crisis, it is extremely important that your organization is up to date with invoicing - no waivers or forgiveness this year for late invoicing

- Contract Negotiations
 - If you are awarded partial funds you will have the opportunity to amend your proposal during the contract negotiations and during the workplan input process
- o OAC Budget Update
 - Full packet from 2.12
 - 24-25 Budget Summary:
 - RFP pot projected to be at ~ \$82 mil
 - Guaranteed 10% cuts this year, about \$8 mil (cuts from work orders, operations, carry forward from prior years, and unspent funds)
 - Tentative 5% contingency cuts is where we would see cuts to grantees (\$1 mil cut from 4 diff strategy areas including Out of School Time, Youth Workforce Development, Outreach & Access, and Justice Services)

 - CODB 3% for 24-26
 - BJC Budget Requests: submit response via Google Forms
 - Instructions & Examples
 - Submit by Monday, March 11th @ 5pm document says 3/8 but got extension for SPWG members due to DCYF decision date
 - Cut requests will be prioritized
 - If you lose DCYF funds or receive less than previous years, this is a great place to request those funds back
