## 5.0 Administrative Report – Ryan

- 5.1 We are well in the process for planning for next year. Fowler is unfortunately expecting a drop in enrollment due to the smaller group of grade 6 students coming into grade 7. We have attracted a number of students from other schools and continue to draw in new students but we still expect few students. Current enrollment is 330 and next year, we are expecting 290.
- 5.2 We were proud of our senior basketball teams who both won the Tier 2 Division Championships this year. We were grateful to have outside coaches lead these teams to success and were proud of the athletes who represented Fowler so well.
- 5.3 We are so grateful to everyone who contributed to the Lenten Campaign project to support Catholic Social Services and their immigration services. With the beautiful baskets that each homeroom created, we were able to raise over \$2200! As a division, we blew the fundraising goal out of the water and we know it's thanks to the amazing families we work with every day.
- 5.4 We celebrated a beautiful dramatization of the Passion the week before Spring Break. One of our gr 9 classes, with the help of Religion Teacher and Faith Lead Peggy Dugan, did an incredible job of demonstrating what Jesus went through and provided everyone with a powerful and prayerful experience.
- 5.5 We also celebrated an amazing Easter mass with our feeder school Holy Family School at Holy Family Parish on April 5th. Both schools contributed to the ministries and the music was top notch.

- 5.6 We brought 45 students to Marmot for our annual ski trip this year. They day was a success and everyone enjoyed themselves without injury. We hope to fill that second bus next year to have even more students able to enjoy.
- 5.7 April 11th was Fowler's presentation of the Wizard of Oz junior. What a show! Under the direction of Michael Molzan, the kids pulled off a great show. It was great that Holy Family School was also involved and had some of their students in the production. What a great way to build a connection between the 2 schools!
- 5.8 Our Bike-a-thon is just around the corner on May 3rd. Our goal is to raise \$40,000 this year but we have some work to do to reach that. Thanks to Mr Ludtke who does an amazing job organizing a tremendously fun day for the students.
- 5.9 Our Jasper Band Trip is coming up on May 10th. Ryan Herbold is looking forward to a joint trip with GH primeau this year and we have about 35 Fowler Falcons attending.
- 5.10 Fowler brought in an organization called Live Different this past week. It was a dynamic presentation. Live Different helps students learn, connect, and do something meaningful. Some of our students signed up for a follow-up workshop with them for a deeper dive into how to be leaders in our school and community.

The theme was the Power of Possibility - building hope and resilience through self-belief.

- 5.11 Final exams are just around the corner. Fowler will be piloting the new digital PATs for gr 9s, which will streamline the process. Students will be practicing with the new platform in the next little bit. Parents, please check the school calendar for the final exam dates so you can ensure your children are not absent.
- 5.12 Gr 9 Farewell is in the process of being planned. A survey is being sent to the students and to parents to receive feedback to help us plan. Right now, it's scheduled on June 21st at 4pm at Holy Family Parish. It starts with mass in the parish and is followed by a reception in the parish hall.
- 5.13 This year Awards Night is on June 26th at 2pm. We know that this time is challenging for some families but it's limited as we work around SACHS grad mass that night at 7pm and SACHS grad the next day on the 27th.
