- 22 "Mark this, then, you who forget God, or I will tear you apart, and there will be no one to deliver.
- 23 Those who bring thanksgiving as their sacrifice honor me;

to those who go the right way

I will show the salvation of God."

SCRIPTURE - LUKE 12:32-40 "Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. Sell your possessions, and give alms. Make purses for yourselves that do not wear out, an unfailing treasure in heaven, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. "Be dressed for action and have your lamps lit; be like those who are waiting for their master to return from the wedding banquet, so that they may open the door for him as soon as he comes and knocks.
