- Liberal Democrats have made 132 net gains in council areas represented by cabinet ministers.
- The party has seized control of six of those councils.
- Highlights include taking control of both Surrey Heath and Guildford, home to Michael Gove's Surrey constituency, winning Chichester where Gillian Keegan's seat is located, eight gains in Jeremy Hunt's Waverley District, and winning control of Mid Devon council in Mel Stride's constituency.
