- 22 factors/indicators came out to determine what makes "great" school
- Narrowed down to 8 indicators and shared during the presentation
 - 1. Extended High School Graduation Rate
 - 2. Improving Student Group Performance
 - 3. Postsecondary Outcomes Employed, Enlisted and Enrolled
 - 4. Postsecondary Preparation Inputs
 - 1. Extra/Intra-Curricular Activities
 - 2. Durable Skills
 - 3. Chronic Absenteeism
 - 4. School Climate
