

Coastal Rowing Committee Terms of Reference

September 2023

Purpose

The Coastal Rowing Committee (CRC) has been established by Rowing BC to support coastal rowing in British Columbia.

Responsibilities and Reporting

The CRC is responsible to:

- Provide quarterly reports regarding the steps taken to ensure the rowing community in BC benefits from the further development of Coastal Rowing, and on-going role of the CRC:
- 2. Provide an annual report ahead of the Rowing BC AGM, and present to the membership, as appropriate, on the path of Coastal Rowing in BC.

Composition and Terms

The CRC shall comprise between 4 and 7 persons one of whom shall be a member of the Rowing BC Board. The CRC shall have representation from Rowing BC membership with experience in Coastal Rowing from Vancouver Island, the Lower Mainland and geographical representation from outside of the Lower Mainland or Vancouver Island. The make-up of the CRC shall strive for gender balance. The CRC will identify a chairperson from amongst its members.

Meetings

The CRC will meet as required and when called by the Chairperson. Meetings will be facilitated via conference call.

Authority

The CRC has the authority to:

- 1. Write reports and recommendations to the Executive Director of Rowing BC;
- 2. Present a report to the Rowing BC Membership at the Rowing BC AGM;
- 3. Raise issues to the board, openly or in camera, as required.

Budget

Rowing BC will support the CRC with the means to hold the necessary meetings as determined by the Chairperson. Rowing BC recognizes that some recommendations may require further budgeting considerations to implement.
