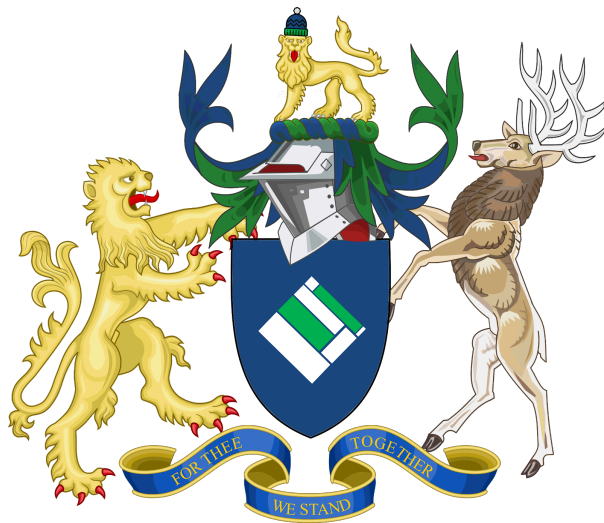

§1 Citation

§2 Background

The Cupertino Alliance prides itself on being among the top developmental organizations in the community. If you check the Development section of the CA MicroWiki page, you’ll find eleven projects, which is excellent. However, many of these projects have fallen inactive in some way or another. There have been multiple calls from delegates to revive this part of our mission. This Act intends to specify the programs that will be created or revived and how they will be managed.

§3 Programs

1. The Ministry of Press and Promotion must oversee the creation of PDF versions of Chapters 1 and 2 of the Cupertino Guides hosted on the MicroWiki. ^[see 1]
 - a. A text channel must be made where these guides can be easily accessible by all delegates. All guides should also be published to the Cupertino Alliance Printer.
2. The Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs must publish a clear and defined guide for rating articles under the Edinburgh System and encourage delegates to rate member articles using the system. ^[see 2]
3. The Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs must modernize and oversee the Bristol Plan to aid in the development of member nation MicroWiki pages. ^[see 3]

§4 Voiding of this Act

This Act may be voided with a fifty-one percent majority vote in the Parliament of the Cupertino Alliance.
