

2023 Plans

Since 2023 is my tenth year doing this, I want to go all in as much as I possibly can. The overall goal here is to finally, *finally* get to at least 300,000 subscribers. I've uh... been in stasis for a touch too long, lol.

**This is all plans; things are subject to change. Life can get in the way and there is a chance that something more pressing may air. Also, I have been known to bite off more than I can chew in the past. :P*

Animated Atrocities (Big)

- High Guardian Spice: This is planned for February, towards the actual anniversary of my channel. It has taken so long because there is a huge amount of things wrong with the overall series: the poor production, the terrible messaging of the show, how it fails as a fantasy series, how it fails with basic logic, how it fails with storytelling, etc. The review is definitely over an hour; and might even approach 2, and it still feels like I've barely scratched the surface.
- Mulan 2020: This is one I've been hesitant to do for awhile. It's like HGS, in that every aspect is bad: historical accuracy, characterization, its faith to either the original Disney film or the Chinese poem, and... its politics. Despite my reputation, I've grown to really dislike talking about movies/shows with bad politics. It's like talking about grossout, it feels very repetitive. HGS; Fairview; the Steven Universe PSA's; Little Mermaid & Snow White's remakes; Q-Force; Santa, Inc.; Masters of the Universe: Revelation. That's just animation from *just* this decade (the trend has been prominent since 2016). There is only so many ways you can say "this show/movie/whatever about sexism is *actually very sexist!*" However, in 2023, I'm planning on approaching this kind of stuff as more of a challenge than an outright obstacle.
 - Everything else I used as examples are also equally prone to being reviewed. Mulan 2020 is the one I am most familiar with.
- Danny Phantom Season 3: I said that I was going to do this during Nick-O-Rama wave 1; I think its time I do this.
- Fairview: This one is a challenge to myself. I don't know if this is "the worst cartoon ever", but its something I hate more than any other cartoon. More than any other piece of media. It floats around the "too bad to review" area. This might sound controversial or crazy, but I do believe this is like actual "hate propaganda." Literally its only saving grace is how incompetent it is. *If* I do manage to review this, I'll go more in depth there.
- Bobbleheads: The Movie: This... is a MOVIE. It's real.
- Boss Baby: This movie is also real, unfortunately.

Animated Atrocities (Smaller Projects)

- Academy of Magic: This film is a bafflingly bad one. It's in league with Elf Bowling or Tentacolino. I like to call it "Frozen Anna Goes to Hogwarts". Look at the trailers sometime if you're curious.
- Fairly Oddparents "Timmy's Secret Wish": This is the most requested Fairly OddParents episode I've yet to review.
- Family Guy: "You Can't Handle the Booth" The most hated Family Guy episode I've yet to review.
- King of the Hill: "Bobby Goes Nuts": Both of the King of the Hill reviews I have made are... terrible. I'd like at least one good one.
- Simpsons: "Love is a Many Strangled Thing": This is another infamous Simpsons episode.
- Friendship is Magic: "Dragon Quest": Friendship is Magic videos don't get me many views, so this one is a maybe depending on where I am. But if I'm in a comfortable position, this is the next FiM I want to tackle.
- Hey Arnold: The Movie: It's a bad movie, but its one of those reviews I pick because I think there are some good jokes I can tell with it. (If you've seen the movie, you're probably familiar with Deep Voice).
- Happy Feet: This movie is actually fucking bonkers.
- Scooby Doo: Return to Zombie Island: You blew it up. You maniacs blew it up!
- Norm of the North 3: Because yes.

Admirable Animation

- Eddsworld: This is another one that's been a long time coming. I've wanted to do an episode on Eddsworld for a very long time, but its been very difficult to talk about, with all of the drama around the show itself and the fandom surrounding it.
- Phineas and Ferb: One of my most popular admirable animations is of the Phineas and Ferb episode "Dude, We're Getting the Band Back Together", which is a great episode; but I only had the barest understanding of the show when I made the review.
- Top 20 Best Animated Theme Songs: I think that its easier to actually make a *new* video than get the old one uncopyright blocked. Besides, plenty of new amazing theme songs have been made in the 9 years since I made this one. Making music-related videos is always a joy at any rate.
- Background Music: This is a weird one, but in terms of appreciating animation, the background music (not the theme songs or showtunes within the show, but the music that plays under dialogue and scenes) is *the* most underrated aspect of a cartoon. It really does make shows like Avatar, or My Life As a Teenage Robot, Hey Arnold, or Courage.
- Dexter's Lab: Either the D&D episode or the Star Trek episode (maybe a double feature). Dexter's Lab is another show that I've had rotten luck covering in the past. Both episodes are pretty bad. I'd like to give the show at least one good review. And not misunderstand the show so hard I say that it "doesn't have anime references."
- Owl House/Amphibia: These are the new shows everyone is telling me to see. I'm definitely going to be watching them. There's a chance I don't like them enough to

review, so I'm not going to promise something I'm not completely passionate about, but I am going to give them a shot.

- SpongeBob SquarePants: "Karen's Virus": This is the best episode of SpongeBob; I don't care.
- Simpsons: "Brick Like Me": I should be nice to this show in a situation that doesn't have something to do with a "current events" situation.
- Short Films Collection: This is going to be an update to "Web Animations", where I'll count traditional short films as well, since the definition between the two is getting nebulous.
- My Life as a Teenage Robot: This is a show I like a lot more now than I did growing up. It's a show I like watching, and thus it's a show I like talking about.
- Welcome to Demon School: This, apparently, is the kind of anime that I like. I find it hilarious; and it uses specific tropes that I really seem to like. I'd describe it as a "reverse torture porn." Where a character keeps getting positive things that they absolutely do not want. I don't know why, but I find that absolutely hilarious.

Other Major Projects

- Nick-O-Rama: Nick-O-Rama, I've come to realize is a series that *must* be a daily thing. What I'm going to TRY and do is what I failed to do the first time around, and do 31 different Nicktoons/"Nick"toons that air one a day throughout December. I will start with project as early as January to make sure that this can actually be done.
- Top 25 Most Disturbing Cartoon Episodes: This is my most popular video ever, and it was released over a decade ago. I want to do a follow-up to this, adding in new episodes that didn't exist or find selections I think are more appropriate. I'll be releasing each segment as a short throughout October (which means it might be a top 31) and then release a full video on Halloween.
- Top 20 Worst Cartoons of All Time: People have often asked me if I was planning on doing a "worst cartoons of the 70's" list. I've considered it, but it would have a very similar problem to the 80's list. The worst cartoons of the 80's were boring and thus boring to talk about. The worst cartoons of the 70's are all hyper derivative. There are only so many Scooby Doo rehashes you can put on a list before it gets stale. So, what I'll do, in a cap for this pseudo series (unless I make it to 2030) is to do a Top 20 Worst Cartoons of All Time.
 - The rules will also be rearranged a bit, so I can put things on it like Ren & Stimpy's Adult Party Cartoon; and I won't count in "meta" information, which I did for both Wacky World of Tex Avery and Family Guy (the former shot on a man's legacy; the latter had a terrible influence on the state of animation and resorted to shock shlock).
- Top 10 Best/Worst Episodes of Johnny Test: Yes, really.

- Top 10 Best/Worst Friendship is Magic Episodes: Long long time ago, I said that I was going to review every single episode of this show. I might do like a vlog-style recap on my second channel, but I do think picking out the top 10 best or worst episodes is a good cap on that. Plus you all get to see if Putting Your Hoof Down still makes me crazy.
- Top 10 Best Cartoons of the 2000's: I think its about time that I start on the other end of this. Its probably better to start with "Best of the 2010's" at this point, but I am *far* more familiar with 2000's cartoons, so there's less ground to cover.

Other Minor Projects

- Foster's Home For Imaginary Friends: I'm going to do what I did with Total Drama Island. I want to take a second look at this show, because its fascinating. In the mid 2000's, this was seen as a classic - one of the best cartoons on CN. However, while the other shows around it, like Puffy Ami Yumi, Chowder, Flapjack have only become more beloved in time, Foster's reputation has plummeted.
- Hi Hi Puffy Ami Yumi: This is the show I think I was the most unfairly harsh to. Like... I don't know why I picked on it so much back in the day. With the onslaught of the mediocre 2000's cartoons, I don't know why I picked *this* one over something like "Squirrel Boy" or "My Gym Partner's a Monkey"
- Class of 3000: A show I've been promising to talk about for awhile. It *might* not be as good as I remember, but we shall see.
- Onward: Onward is a film that I think works against itself in a lot of ways. It makes it very interesting to talk about. A magical world in the modern age seems like a *fascinating* idea. However, this isn't about a magical world in the modern age. Its just... regular ass people in a regular ass world. They look like elves and centaurs, but they're regular ass people doing regular ass things.
- Code Lyoko: Sometimes I take my job as an opportunity to check out a show I never was able to get into growing up or whatever. This is one of those times. I never managed to watch through Code Lyoko before.
