**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Stephanie Kolnick made a motion to approve the April 6th, 2026 minutes. Jane Sarjeant seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

**Math Data Research**

Keri Snowden presented data showing student Math trends over the last 5 years. Mariann Mahar explained to the committee how the SAT does not align with the Common Core Standards. A discussion followed. Ms. Mahar and Ms. Snowden helped facilitate a discussion on the sequence of courses in Math and the positives and negatives of the SVS sequence.

**Counseling Department Update**

Silvia Oullette shared the following highlights:

- A senior survey was created through Naviance so counselors can get a sense of what worked and what didn't work for seniors during their final year of high school. Questions focused on post-secondary plans and reasons for making these plans.

**Follow Up from April 6th, 2026 Meeting**

During the April meeting, the committee asked about the sequence of courses at SVS. Keri Snowden, Marianne Mahar, and Silvia Oullette led a discussion that explored how and why SVS sequences courses.

**Math Pathways Update**

The purpose of the meeting was to brainstorm and discuss the ways SVS can ensure success for all Math students.

- Keri Snowden explained Horizon Data and its purpose. At our next meeting, Marianne Maher will present this data in more detail.
- The committee discussed how SVS prepares grade 8 students for Algebra.
- The committee asked for more information on SAT scores (Math) across the last 7-8 years.
