

## Notice to all adult KWHRA hockey leagues

Regarding: <u>The wearing of CSA Approved goaltender masks</u>

Hockey Canada prohibits Goaltenders from wearing Non-CSA wide-eyed cats eye face masks.

CARHA amended its policy in 2012 to allow the cats-eye goalie mask at the member's discretion, stipulating that any resulting facial injury would NOT be covered by CARHA insurance.

KWHRA notifies all partner leagues and tournaments of the above and requires written confirmation from them regarding their choice in this matter. KWHRA officials will apply the rule according the confirmation provided by individual partner groups.

Not all partners are CARHA members and they should consider their League-specific circumstance and risk exposure before rendering confirmation to KWHRA.
