New Business -

1) Student Success Plan

- -New Communications Coordinator for the SSRCE (also shared with TCRCE)- Ashley Gallant
- 6) COVID-19- Start-up, PTI & Scenario 2
- -Start-up was a bit different this year (WHMIS training, masks, etc.)
- -Staff and students have been great following the guidelines
- -A detailed plan was made for the SSRCE before start up with the guidelines specific to our building
- -Scenario 2 is starting to be planned now by Stacy and Terry to be submitted to the SSRCE soon; due to the square footage of our rooms, there would only be a couple of changes for rooms that may need to be switched. In order to go to Scenario 2 Public Health would take control of this
- -Parent Teacher Interviews this time around will be carried out virtually or by phone
