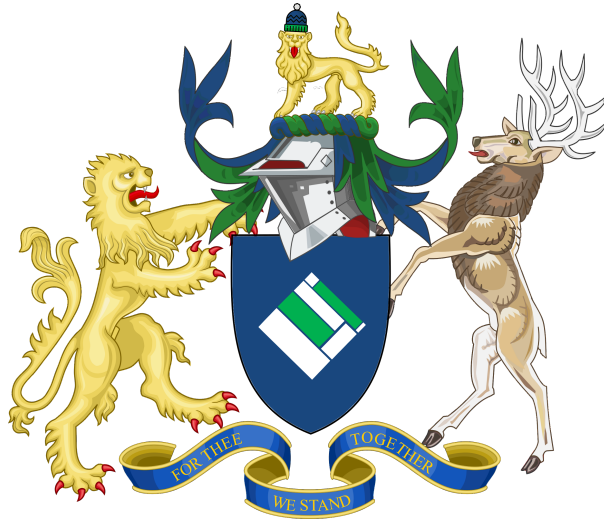

§1 Citation

This act may be referred to:

1. “An Act to Reestablish the Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs” as its long name.
2. “MicroWiki Ministry Reestablishment Act” as its short name.

§2 Background

1. The MicroWiki Improvement Ministry was initially formed in May of 2020 and was later combined with the Ministry of Public Affairs to form the Ministry of Press & Promotion by the Cabinet Reorganization Act, 2021. It has become apparent that this combination should be repealed so that the two portions can benefit from a dedicated Minister.

§3 Necessary Amendments

1. Amend Article 47 of the Charter of the Cupertino Alliance, 2021, to include:
j) Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs

§4 Structure and Duties

1. The Cupertino Alliance shall establish the Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs.
2. The Ministry will be overseen by a Minister and optionally a Deputy Minister, appointed through the provisions within Article 49 of the Charter of the Cupertino Alliance, 2021.
3. The Ministry of Press and Promotion will transfer the following duties to the Ministry of MicroWiki Affairs:
 - a. The upkeep of all MicroWiki articles relevant to the Cupertino Alliance.
 - b. Management of all Cupertino Alliance projects related to MicroWiki.
4. Projects to be overseen by this ministry:
 - a. Edinburgh System
 - b. Glasgow System
 - c. Cupertino Guides MicroWiki Articles
 - d. Informative Template Project

§5 Voiding of this Act

This Act may be voided with a fifty-one percent majority vote in the Parliament of the Cupertino Alliance.
