- The essay may discuss the nutritional benefits of American raised beef, cooking ease, versatile recipes, etc.
- Include a cover sheet with the student's name, address, phone number and high school. No name is allowed on the essay. It must be postmarked by Friday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The two winners will be announced by May 2025.
- The essay will be judged on grammar and creative content. A bibliography is required. The scholarship check will be presented to the winner when we have proof of registration to a college or trade school or a receipt showing tuition payment. Please mail the essay to:
