# **Trip Details**

We will be taking 12 4th and 5th grade students on a Halloween-themed day of exploration in the ghost town of Silver City! This day will be filled with a history lesson of the abandoned mining town, short hikes around Silver City, and a fun

Halloween-themed picnic.

\*Please note the road to Silver City is a gravel road through the Owyhees. In the case there is precipitation in the week leading up to or during the day of this expedition an alternative location will be selected to avoid impassable slick roads.

13:00- Continue exploring Silver City

14:00- Load bus and depart Silver City

16:00- Arrive back at Sage Middleton for pick up

### Hazards

<u>Wolf-</u>Probability of a wolf sighting is low. To further mitigate the risk of a wildlife incident, the group will be traveling as one for the entire expedition.

<u>Coyote-</u> Probability of coyote sightings is low. To further mitigate the risk of a wildlife incident, the group will be traveling as one for the entire expedition.

<u>Cougar-</u> Probability of a cougar sighting is low. We will always stay in our group and make lots of noise to prevent run in with cougars

<u>Rattlesnake-</u> At this time of year and with cooler temperatures, we do not expect to see rattlesnakes. In case of a warmer day, we will teach students how to ID where rattlesnakes like to hang out, how to avoid them, and what to do in case of a sighting.

Poison Oak- we will teach students how to identify and avoid this plant

# Safety

# **Experienced Faculty**

Christina Pak is an experienced outdoor leader as well as trained in wilderness aid capable of safely handling any first aid or emergency situations. She is a licensed CDL driver and experienced in driving and transporting students in the school vehicle.

# Communication

The group will be equipped with cell phones to communicate with the person of contact (POC) as well as a satellite communication device for when traveling in areas without cell service. In the case of an emergency the trip leader will inform the POC who will contact families.

### First Aid

Wilderness first aid kits will be with our trained faculty at all times. These kits do not contain epinephrine or antivenin.

### **Medical Facilities**

The nearest emergency department is <u>St. Alphonsus of Nampa</u>, an hour and a half drive from Silver City.

# **Physical Demands**

Students will need to be capable of hiking/walking between 2-3 miles over the course of 3 hours of exploration.
