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Vevo Camera System FAQs

What is the Vevo Camera System?

The Vevo Camera System consists of two cameras that automatically record a complete game and then stitches the two recordings together using software to automatically identify things like goals, kick-offs, and highlights. OVF Alliance has four Vevo cameras and their corresponding tripods that require specific hardware and a subscription for video processing. This system is ideal for recording game film and creating player-focused clips. The Vevo cameras are controlled via a smartphone, with video stored on the camera. Then the video is uploaded to Vevo servers after recording is completed.

Who can use the Vevo System? When and where can we use the Vevo System?

The Vevo systems are available to record every home match at our local YMCA facility. Due to our fourth available camera, we will assign one to our older and more competitive teams. This fourth camera prioritizes our teams and players competing at the highest levels, looking for support in earning playing opportunities in college and beyond. Please inform your coach or manager if you want to volunteer to run Vevo videos for your team. Club staff monitors the cameras' status and ensures all the videos are uploaded and annotated, illustrating the club's playing philosophy.

How do I use the Vevo Camera?

- Download the Veo App to your smartphone, and follow the instructions.
 1. Turn the Camera on with the power button on the back side.
 2. Open the Veo App and follow the instructions to connect to the camera.
 3. Raise the camera on the tripod and adjust the camera so that you can see the whole field.
 4. Just before the game begins, hit record in the app.
 5. After the game, re-open the app, connect to the camera, and press stop.
 6. Press the power button to turn off the camera.
 7. Break down the stand, put the camera back in the case, and place it in the YMCA Storage room.

How do we get the video off the camera?

Getting the videos off the camera requires an account and a subscription. After you return the camera to the YMCA Storage facility, Ernesto will facilitate the video upload and annotate the match. Then, we will share a link with the coach and manager, who will add their coaching points and share them with the team.

How do we request a Veo Camera System to record our games?

Since the cameras are primarily used for home games, you do not need to request to use them; we will bring them to the first match, and then pass them on to the next team so they can record their match. However, we do ask that someone, who is not the coach, on your team, volunteers to use the Veo app to set up the tripod and use the app to start and stop the recordings. Again, please notify your coach or team manager if you want to volunteer for this role. The last team to play will then place the camera in storage. Ernesto will assign the fourth camera to an older team on a weekly basis.
