7/30/25 & 7/31/25	T-TESS Orientation
Ongoing NEO	

- For any new teacher to the district or profession and for teachers never previously appraised under T-TESS.
 - Must be completed by the final day of the first 3 weeks of school and at least 2 weeks before the first observation.
- For late hires, orientation must be completed no later than 2 weeks prior to the first observation and within 3 weeks from the hire date. In Hutto ISD, T-TESS Orientation is part of New Employee Orientation (NEO).

9/2/25 T-TESS Annual Refresher for all Returning Teachers

 Must be completed by the final day of the first 3 weeks of school and at least 2 weeks before the first observation.

9/15/25 T-TESS Waiver (if applicable) Due Date

- Teachers must meet certain criteria to have a <u>T-TESS waiver</u>.
- Teachers who wish to be eligible for TIA consideration are ineligible for a TTESS Waiver.
- Teachers in eligible teaching roles in the first year of TIA data collection for that particular role are ineligible for a waiver.
- Directions on the waiver will go out to those eligible by 9/5 with specific considerations for TIA eligibility and data collection impacts.

9/10/25 Teacher Goal Setting and Professional Development (GSPD) Plan for New to District/Profession Teachers

For teachers **new to the district/profession** and for teachers who have never been appraised under T-TESS:

- GSPD plan **conference** is required with their appraiser prior to submitting the plan.
- Teacher must be guided through the GSPD and student growth measure process.
- Plan must be submitted in Eduphoria within 6 weeks of orientation.
- Student Learning Objectives (SLOs) are also due at this time.
- Late hires: GSPD Plan with SLOs are due within 6 weeks of NEO.

9/23/25 Goal Setting and Professional Development (GSPD) Plan for Returning Teachers

- Returning teachers review goal(s) established at the EOY conference and submit changes in Eduphoria within 6 weeks from the first day of school.
- Student Learning Objectives (SLOs) are also due at this time.
