

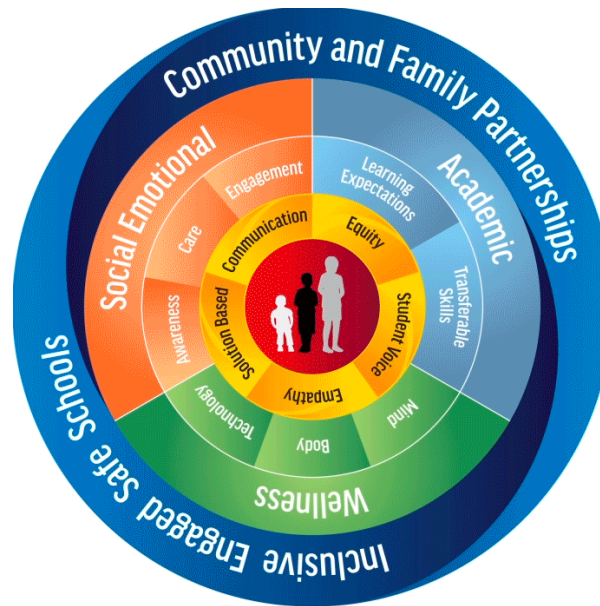
District Vision Statement
