• Prison Correspondence Program (Various dates/times)

Seeking volunteers with a meditation practice, an understanding of basic Buddhist teachings, and half an hour to volunteer a month. We connect Buddhist practitioners in jail and prison with volunteer pen pals. Get matched as a pen pal with a person who is incarcerated. All mail comes through the SFZC offices to maintain anonymity.
