#### FOOTBALL GAME DAYS

TO SCHOOL: Cheerleaders will wear jerseys with white varsity pleated skirt. Hair half up half down with white sparkle bow. You will NOT need to bring your practice clothes for class on gamedays. Keep in mind that you'll need a different bow for the game when in uniform, so be sure to check the schedule.

TO FOOTBALL GAME: Cheerleaders will wear uniforms, navy blue sports bras without straps showing, white no show socks, cheer shoes, and hair in a high ponytail with team bow (colors are indicated on schedule above). Cheerleaders must always have their team jacket in their backpack (these will be issued mid September). Sometimes the temps will drop during our October football games, so everyone will be expected to have their jackets at ALL games.

#### FOOTBALL GAMES—REPORTING TIMES

Cheerleaders are responsible for their own transportation to and from all games. We do not have buses. It's important you are ON TIME so that we can properly warm up stunts and pyramids. Points will be deducted for each minute you are late. If you're running late, you must text Coach Wandersee (972-689-6347) and Coach Matte (845-797-3078).

## WHAT TO KEEP IN YOUR CHEER BAG—GAME DAYS

- Extra hair ties/rubber bands/bobby pins if needed
- Personal hygiene items
- Tide stick
- Wipes/hand sanitizer
- Phone (only used with permission)

## PICK-UP FROM GAMES

Cheerleaders are expected to be picked up from all games within 10 minutes of dismissal. Parents, your daughter will not be supervised outside of our assigned game time, so it's important you pick up on time. If they are staying to watch another game, they MUST bring a change of clothes. They cannot stay in uniform. They must also have a parent present at the game if they choose to stay.
