Word of the day: Monday-get dressed (on bd)

Tuesday-<u>do up</u> (on bd)

Phrasal Verb: try on sth/try sth on – to put on a piece of clothing to see if it fits and how it looks

- 1. You should <u>try</u> the shoes <u>on</u> before you buy them.
- 2. I went to the change room to try on the dress.

Idiom: in style/in fashion – clothes that are popular now; the current fashion or style

- 1. Capri pants are in style right now.
- 2. What kind of jeans are in fashion this year?
