🇵🇸 Attention Students and Parents! Important Dress Code Updates for the 2024-25 School Year 🇵🇸

We are excited to share the NEW High School Dress Code changes for the upcoming school year. Please review the updated guidelines to ensure everyone is ready to start the year off right! 👗 👕

♦ Tops:

- **OLD:** Solid colors only, no logos (except SSD), limited color choices.
- **NEW:** Any patterns and colors are allowed! Spirit wear is acceptable.
- **NEW:** Crew neck t-shirts, sweatshirts (no hoods), and polo shirts in any color or pattern. Shirts must cover the waistline, shoulders, back, and have sleeves.
- **IMPORTANT:** Hooded sweatshirts are not permitted as in school attire. This is considered an outer garment and must be removed and hung in the student's locker during school. No graphic printed shirts/sweatshirts (e.g., professional sports teams/bands).

♦ Bottoms:

- **OLD:** Limited colors, no dresses allowed.
- **NEW:** Any color bottoms in chino (khaki) type material.
- **NEW:** Dresses/Skirts are now permitted (must be fingertip length or longer).
- **NEW:** Athletic shorts are allowed (must be fingertip length or longer).
- **IMPORTANT:** Jeans, sweatpants, leggings, and yoga pants are **NOT PERMITTED**.

♦ Shoes:

- **NEW:** Must have a backing or strap behind the heels. Toes must be enclosed.

♦ Additional Guidelines:

- Clothing cannot display inappropriate wording, messages, images, political speech, or references to drugs, alcohol, or vaping.
- NO attire that is deemed to be a representation of gang affiliation.
- No hats, caps, bandanas, hoods, sheisty masks, or sunglasses.

♦ Backpacks:

- All backpacks must be clear or mesh for safety purposes.

♦ Water Bottles:

- Must be made of clear plastic material and not to exceed 32 oz.
