Grammar:

- I wish and if only

To talk about how we would like things to be different now or in the future we use **I wish** or **if only** and the simple past tense.

I wish I was like everyone else.

You wish you could afford both.

To talk about regrets we have about things we did in the past, we often use **I wish** and **if only** and the past perfect.

If only I had taken that course.

I wish I had seen it sooner.

- I would prefer to / it if, It's time, I'd rather / sooner

To say we think someone should do something we use **It's time** + simple past

It's about time something nice happened to you.

To talk about our own preferences we use **I'd rather/sooner** + base verb or **I'd rather** + infinitive

I'd rather say nothing

I'd sooner ignore him and sit with my friends.

I'd prefer to go swimming.

If the subject of the second verb is different from the subject of **I'd rather /sooner/prefer** we use **I'd rather /sooner** + past tense or **I'd prefer it if** +past tense

I'd prefer it if you didn't talk about her like that.

Grammar:

- Reported speech

When we report what someone said we change the verb tense, the words referencing time and pronouns.

I'll be in town this evening.

He said he would be in town that evening.

- Reported questions and requests

For reported yes/ no questions we use if or whether

Is your job dangerous?

He asked me if my job was dangerous

In reported request we use asked

Can you run 10 kilometers, please?

He asked me to run 10 kilometers
