LOCKER ROOM RULES

RAIDER PRIDE Earning the privilege to be a **Shaker Raider** carries a responsibility to represent the very best of

Raider Nation through actions, behaviors, and choices that reflect pride for self, family, school,

team, and community.

APPROVED USE Only rostered, eligible, and in-season athletes are permitted to use the locker room for equipment

and uniform storage, changing, or using bathroom or shower facilities.

BEHAVIOR & CONDUCT Appropriate, responsible behavior is required at all times. School and district policy strictly prohibits

abuse, bullying, fighting, hazing, harassment, unsafe conduct, vandalism, and vulgarity of any kind.

PRIVACY Athletes must respect others' privacy and personal space in the locker room at all times.

TECHNOLOGY Use of cell phones and other devices that contain audio, photo, and/or video recording technology is

strictly prohibited in the locker room at all times.

SAFETY & SECURITY Athletes must lock all personal items and valuables in their lockers; respect school and others'

property; and not share their locker or locker combination with others.

LOST / STOLEN ITEMS Athletes must immediately report lost or stolen items to the Athletic Department, school

administration, and security. The school and district are **not** responsible for lost or stolen items.

LOITERING Loitering in the locker room is strictly prohibited. Athletes must enter and vacate the locker room in

a timely manner before (no more than 30 minutes prior) and immediately after athletic events.

COACH / STAFF ENTRY Prior to entry, staff/coaches must first knock, announce themselves and their intent, request

permission for entry, and wait a reasonable amount of time for an answer before permissibly

entering the locker room.

FOOD & DRINK Food and drinks are strictly prohibited in the locker room at all times.

CLEANLINESS Athletes are responsible for keeping their lockers and the locker room clean at all times.

NOISE Athletes must maintain respectable noise levels (language, music, conversation, etc.) at all times.

VIOLATIONS Any violation of locker room rules must be reported **immediately** to the Athletic Department or a

staff member; will be dealt with according to student, athletic, and staff codes of conduct; and may

result in suspension, expulsion, termination, and/or referral to law enforcement.
