Committee Guidelines

- 1. The Full Membership and Governing Committee are who can take action committees work to brainstorm, research, and implement action items
- 2. All projects (funded or unfunded) need board/membership approval
- 3. Communication
 - a. To Membership via chair's email, official parent Facebook group, monthly report shared at meetings
 - b. To Board via April (PIE) or monthly report
 - c. Chairs can designate another committee member to handle communication if they would like.
- 4. All fundraising or donation requests needs board approval
- 5. Monthly updates are given to the board about ALL project ideas, needs, funding etc. Due the day before each governing committee meeting.

Approval Process

- 1. Committee brainstorms ideas and researches cost options
- 2. Committee chair sends monthly report to governing board with proposal
- Governing board evaluates proposal, checks with treasurer for fund availability, gets school approval, and then adds to agenda for full membership if necessary
- 4. Full membership gives feedback, votes on funding, and approves proposal
- 5. Committee implements proposal

- Project overview
- Any costs or donations needed (sources included)
- Projected timeline
- Connection to Reggio Philosophy and/or School Mission
- Long-term sustainability plan who will maintain, care for, continue the work in order to support this project long-term if needed
