In August 1, 2023, the school launched the **School Initiated Intervention (SII)** program, a strategic initiative designed to address the diverse needs of students facing significant life challenges. These include learners juggling work responsibilities, expectant and young mothers, students dealing with chronic health conditions, and others encountering personal hardships that may hinder their ability to focus on their studies. Recognizing the unique struggles faced by these individuals, the program aims to provide targeted support to ensure their continued engagement in education and to help them achieve their academic goals despite the obstacles in their path.

The **School Initiated Intervention (SII)** program takes a holistic approach to support students, offering a range of resources and strategies tailored to meet their specific needs. A key component of the program is the use of **Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM)**, designed to provide flexible and adaptive learning solutions for students who face challenges that prevent them from participating in regular classroom settings. These include modular learning, a flexible and adaptive approach that allows students to continue their education at their own pace and in a setting suited to their unique circumstances. Coupled with emotional and psychological support through counseling services and social interventions such as peer mentoring and community outreach, the program ensures that students are not only able to pursue their education but also develop resilience and confidence to overcome life's challenges.

This initiative reflects the school's unwavering commitment to inclusivity and equity, aligning with its mission to provide every learner with the tools and opportunities necessary for success. The school firmly believes that education is a right, not a privilege, and that no student should be left behind due to circumstances beyond their control. The **school Initiated Intervention (SII)** stands as a testament to this vision, ensuring that even the most vulnerable members of the student body are empowered to reach their full potential.
