

Rocklin High Commencement 2026

General Family Information

We are excited and ready to hold the graduation ceremony for our Graduating Class of 2025. Please read through this information and share it with those in your family whom you intend to bring to Commencement 2026. Below you will find links to more specific information for you and your graduate.

Commencement 2026 will be held in the **Rocklin High School Stadium** on **Friday, June 5, 2026**. It will begin at **7:30 pm**. Graduates are provided 2 VIP tickets and 4 general admission tickets for family and friends to attend this event. There is also room in the stadium every year for more guests. Our stadium is ADA compliant, providing access to four seating areas (two on each side of the stadium) designed for those with mobility challenges. If you plan to have a family member utilizing this area, you may want to consider having another family member bring their own chair in order to accompany them.

The main gates open for ticket holders at 6:30 pm, one hour before the ceremony begins. Once the ticket holders have had a chance to enter, we welcome those in line who have no tickets. This typically happens by 7:10 pm. The ceremony lasts approximately 90 minutes.

We recommend that all who plan to attend Commencement monitor the weather and plan accordingly. Please plan to **bring your own water and snacks so that you are comfortable while in line** waiting for the ceremony. In years of extreme heat we will provide cooling areas.

In addition, we recommend that all attendees **wear comfortable, flat shoes** in order to best manage the different surfaces in the stadium. Heels are not allowed at all on the stadium turf, and most people end up there after the ceremony.

Diplomas will be distributed the day before the ceremony directly to the graduates after they have completed all school business.

Please discuss transportation and parking with your family. Our campus parking is limited and we recommend carpooling as much as possible for both our graduates and attendees.
