Stage 1: Enrollment in Credit-Bearing Internship or Research

To be considered for the Internship Equity Fund, you must first be enrolled in a credit-bearing course tied to your internship or research experience. Work with your department or internship supervisor to confirm course eligibility. You may also enroll through an **EXT course**.

Stage 2: Apply for the Internship Equity Fund
☐ Confirm your financial aid status and FAFSA are current.
Log in to <u>Scholarship Universe</u> and complete the IEF application.
Submit your application by the deadline. Deadlines will be posted on the Internship Equity Fund website .

Only students who complete both stages AND meet eligibility criteria may be awarded funding.



Timeline

- For Fall Internships: Applications Open: September 1st. Deadline to Apply: October 16th
- For Spring Internships: Applications Open: December 22nd. Deadline to Apply: February 16th
- For Summer Internships: Applications Open: TBD
