Miruko is canonically tan-skinned. Some of my icons have her with darker skin. I also headcanon her as Afro-Asian (black and Japanese). If this bothers you, please do not follow.

I will not follow or reply to anyone who glorifies sexism, colorism, pedophilia, or fetishizes lgbt characters/Asian culture within the anime RPC.

FOLLOW BACKS

I do not do 'follow for follow". Do not follow me just to raise your follow count. If you're not planning to interact with me, don't bother coming to my blog. I'll just put you on ignore.

This blog is *MUTUAL EXCLUSIVE*. Meaning I only roleplay to those I follow. I can not follow blogs who do not cut posts, tag posts, steal icons and headcanons, or play whitewashed or "gender-bend" characters. I am also selective, so please be patient with me when I do reply. Do not fill my ask box and IMs begging me to reply/roleplay. You will be unfollowed or blocked.

I do, however, open to roleplay with problematic characters such as Endeavor, Mitsuki, Overhaul, or Mineta. Just please do not abuse or sexually assault my muse.

RP DRAMA

I don't engage in callouts. If you have an issue with another roleplayer, that is between you and them. Please have evidence of the roleplayers problematic behavior. I was a victim of rumors from burn blogs and subjected me to bullying (including racial slurs and doxing, and death threats). I don't want someone suffering the same way their same way over something that may not be true.

I have a handful of roleplaying blogs and each have 100+ followers. I try to memorize everyone's rules. If I make a mistake, it is not intentional. Simply DM me if I mess up. I try my best to leave my partners as comfortable as possible.

SHIPPING

The canon age of my muse is 26. Mun is 30. I only ship her with characters and muns 18+. Miruko x Hawks is my OTP, but I'm open to anyone with chemistry. I do not ship her with minors (ex. UA students). Muse and Mun is of age, adult muses can smut with me.

If you're shy, I have a Discord to do so.

TAGGING

I do post NSFW material, but nothing hardcore. But it will be tagged. Smut will be under 'read more' or 'fade to black'. I do tag politics/social justice posts. I do not roleplay rape (noncon) or pedophilia. I do post/reblog spoilers, so all with be tagged as #bhna spoilers //.

I accept muses who aren't My Hero Academia. This includes OCs. Muns of OCs must follow the same standards as canon characters. I also accept "children" of Miruko. But please do not spam me messages, reblog my OOC posts and threads to get my attention. You still be blocked.

Rumi Usagiyama, also known as Rabbit Hero: Miruko, is the #5 Hero! Her quirk has all the abilities of a rabbit: speed, bouncing back, and great leg strength. She is known as a very tough and confrontational woman,, but she has a weakness for bunnies and needy children. The hero does not belong to any agency nor she wants to. She believes in working alone, yet sometimes partnered with Keigo Takami (Hawks).

Rumi Usagiyama was born in New York, USA through an African American mother and a Japanese father. She is the fifth child out of seven sisters. The Usagiyamas moved to Hiroshima where her father is from. Japanese is her second language and it was difficult for Rumi to adjust.

When she started middle school in Japan, Rumi tried my sports, but she was mainly in wrestling and volleyball. Though Rumi socialized normally in junior high, she preferred to be around older children. Through her older sisters Kiyomi and Hina, she met Shouta Aizawa, Hizashi Yamada, Nemuri Kamaya and Shirakumo Oboro.

Once she came of age, Rumi passed the exams to enter UA and was licensed to be a Pro Hero. Like many young people, All Might was her greatest inspiration. His influence guided her to be one of the school's best students. Under the agency of Best Jeanist, she spent her internship and work study fighting villains. Secretly, she fell in love with a teenage villain who tragically died from heroes. This gave Rumi a different perspective of villains where she could do more for them aside from battle.

As she grew older, Rumi became one of the top pro heroes. She strongly prefers working alone because she feels agencies' rules hold her back from saving lives. But after seeing the pro heroes face All For One, Rumi decides to partner with teams to some degree. She opens internships for younger heroes such as Katsuki Bakugou. Rumi continues her role as no. 5 hero in Japan and strives to go higher in the ranks.

I WAS A CHEERLEADER: Teenage Rumi's marks and powerful quirk invited her to U.A High training under Fiber Hero: Jeanist along with other young heroes-in-training.

FLAMING BUNNIES AND A BABY UNICORN: Rabbit Hero: Miruko Rumi and eldest Todoroki child, Touya, started building their careers while raising their daughter Eri.
