- Explore what engaging in this community of practice might make possible for each of us
- Support the ongoing emergence of a circle of SSM community stewards

Renowned consultant Peter Block laid out this approach, its sources, and the theory behind it in his 2008 book <u>Community: The Structure of Belonging</u>. The conversations are designed as a way for communities that seek to catalyze systemic transformation to practice "a culture of restoration." Ben Roberts has trained with Block and has facilitated well over a hundred of these Conversations on behalf of many different communities.

- Become a carrier of a "culture of restoration" that can replace patterns of patriarchy and other forms of oppression and "power over" behavior.
- Grow a sense of belonging and of shared ownership in the vitality of the CoP
- Support self-organizing to tap into the gifts of community members and to release the
 co-creative energies of the group, in ways that emerge out of and are consistent with the
 Source Vision held by Christine (see below)
- Make space for authentic dissent as a necessary expression that strengthens the community's capacity for commitment and for bringing forth the gifts of its members
