# **IPADS 101**

Course Name: ipad 101 Time Frame: 25 minutes
Unit/Theme: Intro to classroom technology Grade Level: Kindergarten

#### **CONTENT AND SKILLS**

#### **Learning Objectives:**

- Students will learn about the basic functions of the ipad.
- Students will learn how to turn on Ipads and find the Launch Zone.

# **Essential Questions (optional):**

• How can I be respectful with my ipad in the classroom?

#### Students I can statements . . .

- I can log into my ipad independently and find the launch pad.
- I can plug in my headphones and adjust the volume.
- I can use strategies when stuck before asking for help from the teacher.

#### **INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN**

List the steps of the lesson, including instructions for the students. How will you make sure this lesson is culturally responsive?

- Students will come to the rug with ipads and sit around the outside.
- Teacher will have his/her ipad OFF and ready to display.
- Before beginning the lesson, the teacher will have a class discussion about an ipad (K-1. IC. 6).
  - Ask things such as who knows what this device is called?
  - Why do we use this device in school?
  - Why do we use this device at home?
  - Are they used in the community at all? Where? How? (K-1. IC.3)
- Teacher will show students how to use the power button to turn the lpad on.
- Teacher will ask students to do the same.
- Teacher will show students what to do if they are inactive and the screen goes black. There is a small circle button on the bottom that they can push to "wake it up."
- Teacher will then explain to students that we have something called a launch pad that houses all of our educational apps. Teacher will show students how to find the launch zone and ask that they try to find it.
- Teacher will then explain that students must find our school buildings picture. (Note: In our district, there are many buildings) Teacher will click on the correct building and then explore with the students the apps that are available.
- Teacher will choose one app (Starfall) and have students find this from the home screen
- Teacher will then explain to students where headphones go and what to do if he/she cannot hear the volume.
- Students will then go back to their seats, plug in headphones and explore.
- After about ten minutes of exploring, the teacher will bring students back to the rug to discuss findings.
- Students will be encouraged to show a partner something that they found interesting on starfall (K-1. DL. 2)
- Teacher will create an Anchor Chart with a venn diagram about Ipad Use (K-1. IC. 2)
  - May include when it is okay to use, what apps we can use, how to treat it, difference between home and school use, etc.

#### BACKGROUND OR PRIOR KNOWLEDGE

Students must know where to find ipads/headphones in the classroom.
