 - 8.07 11U Associations are allowed to tier internally, provided they do not play in league games or tournaments outside of their association for the spring season. Programs such as MSET and Prospects are permitted, however, associations may not do both tiering and the MSET or Prospect programs.
 - There is discussion of amalgamating the Cowichan Valley to make an 11u AAA Mustangs team for summer ball this year.
 - Asking that no Mustangs teams book bottle drives for the weekends in June as the park is packed with tournaments and special events.
