Steve Boilard is the executive director of the Center for California Studies at the California State University, Sacramento. The Center carries out its mission of “strengthening democratic governance in California” through a variety of programs, including the renowned Capital Fellows Programs, the high school civic education program LegiSchool, state policy research programs, the annual Envisioning California conference, and other programming.

Steve also teaches in a number of different programs, including Sacramento State’s Public Policy and Administration program, the Chicano Latino Youth Leadership Program, the National Council of State Legislature’s Legislative Staff Management Institute, and various other graduate and professional courses. He is a frequent commentator on state policy and politics on Capitol Public Radio and other media outlets.

Prior to coming to Sacramento State in 2012, Steve spent 14 years with the California Legislative Analyst’s Office, where he directed the office’s work related to higher education.
