Project Charter: **Review Harvester Contributions**

Background

Because of Alliance central staff vacancies and the end of LSTA grant support, the DCBP SG will review contributions and re-contributions to the digital collections harvester between 2018 July and December.

Goals

- Support Alliance members with digital collections described with Dublin Core, particularly those who wish to contribute those collections for aggregation in DPLA, Primo, or both
- Ensure compliance with the Alliance's <u>digital collections documentation</u> in support of efficient aggregation
- Identify issues that can be addressed through documentation updates and training rather than one-on-one support

Scope

The group will review contributions and re-contributions to the digital collections harvester. Using the administrative interface and existing documentation and processes, ensure that all required fields are formed correctly and that recommended properties, if present, are also formed correctly. Communicate with institutions/individuals about issues and offer assistance to resolve them. When appropriate, note issues that can be addressed through documentation updates and training. If an issue appears to involve a problem with the harvester, consult with DPLA Ingest Manager.
