### About the Conda Organization

We are a community dedicated to the conda ecosystem. We provide three main functions for the community.

- Project Hosting: We host projects for the conda ecosystem in the [conda] GitHub organization. Hosted projects benefit from the visibility of the conda GitHub organization and the expertise of its members.
- Project Incubation: Members of the community can ask that their conda tool or specification be moved to the [conda-incubator] GitHub organization. This process increases the visibility of the tool/specification and provides a forum for discussion and development. After the tool/specification has reached maturity, the core governance team can call a vote to formally incorporate it into the ecosystem.
- Specifications: We maintain and vote on specifications for the conda ecosystem. These specifications ensure that conda ecosystem is extensible and its tools are interoperable.
