Volunteer Description***

Volunteer Role: Christmas Giving Wreath for Veterans Parishioner Assistant

Locations: Mercy Center as needed. St. Joseph Center as required. Outside Narthex Side Door, near hanging wreath on the wall.

Description of Duties: Assist in the task of creating ornaments, place and replenish ornaments on the tree, answer parishioner questions about the program, and collect donations on the scheduled date for the return of the gifts. Along with other volunteers, transport gift donations to Mercy Center Training for temporary storage until distribution day, Dec. 13, 2025. Communicate with Mercy Ministry (MM) staff regarding questions and/or needed directions.

Impact of the Role: You'll share our Church's mission and our work with those who may be unfamiliar with POP. This helps us to evangelize and make disciples!

Qualifications: Experience with serving others, answering questions, and sharing joy is appreciated. Organizational skills are important. Exhibiting a willingness to learn is helpful. Communication skills are invaluable.

Time Commitment: Five hours, weekly. Much of the work can be managed from home. A mandatory meeting will be held before the outside Church work commences. For two weekends, an additional three to four hours will be a realistic amount of time after Masses on Saturday and Sunday, depending on the number of additional volunteers who can help. Note: This requirement may change.

Training Opportunity: We plan to train the friends and family Team regarding available weekend maintenance support, and available access to buildings, copiers, other equipment, and supplies.
