Announcements:

David B presented the idea of renting the space under the overpass from MoDOT and put up a fence to rent out the space. This idea was not well received by some neighbors.

Mardi Gras Recap: Marcia has a meeting set with Mardi Gras Inc to discuss how we can maximize our profits in the future.

Security: There was a shooting south of Park Avenue. No details are currently available. The 18 Neighborhood Watch signs have been posted around the neighborhood.

Financials: \$3, 640.82

Insurance: Jenn and David met with an insurance broker about getting coverage for the LPCA. He recommended that we have general liability, Fiduciary and Board coverage. Jenn is getting a quote and will report back to the neighborhood.

Alderman Update:

Jack will be splitting his time between us and Lafayette Square's Wed meeting.

Jack spoke about the current news about 3 aldermen who resigned.

Need to focus on getting ARPA funds, Rams funds etc allocated.

Jack is now the Vice chair of the HUD committee.

We are in budget season and he is making decisions about Ward funds. Is the neighborhood still interested in getting speed humps? It was suggested that we get a speed sign that shows motorists how fast they are going on Park Ave. It was also suggested that we have a beefed up crossing at 10<sup>th</sup> and Park. Jack will look into what options we have available to us.

Bird and Lime scooters: they have been banned downtown. Jack is looking into what can be done about them and will report back.

Homeless Citizens: City still has quite a few homeless encampments. They are looking at making another tiny homes area.

House at 10<sup>th</sup> and Morrison has hip high weeds. The mall needs weed control applied. Jack will contact the City about both matters.

10<sup>th</sup> Street Mall: Jack will check with Streets about the boulders that are supposed to be placed about the mall to keep people from driving on it.

Other News:

Bulk trash pickup didn't happen this month.

Website: Cat N would like to be on the committee and help build the website.

Eat Rite is being renovated and will be opening in July.
