The cost is based on a **10 month** tuition program, September - June. Tuition can be paid in full or monthly.

Registration Fee (Non-Refundable)

\$200 - Per Student

Field Day Fridays

Fridays will be a day of hands-on activities on campus. This will not be a typical class day. Some activities may include fishing, garden club, organized sports activities, science projects and experiments, art creations, and community based projects.

Active Membership

Volunteers are needed to teach enrichment activities such as Art, STEM, PE, Missions, and Field Day Fridays, etc. Volunteers will need to pass a background check with a minimal fee. Sign up will be available through Faith First Administrative Office upon receipt of registration fees and a completed background check. There are limited spots available.

Snack/Lunch

Students will be expected to bring their own lunch and snack when they attend the Academy. Students will have a mid-morning snack break and an extended lunch break to include recess. No red dye drinks, caffeinated drinks, or soda are allowed. We also ask that candy be saved for home.

Students will receive benchmark assessments as well as curriculum based assessments to monitor academic progress for their age and individual needs.
