## FannyChmelar's Finalist Speech

Helo it's me fanny!! Coming to you straight from the finals. In this speech I'm gonna detail my game, labelling my high points, and worst points in this game were and shit!! Before we begin, however, I'd like to thank the hosts for organising such an amazing ORG and for casting me and for being such creative and kind hosts!

I'd also like to say congratulations to Zarfot - we both deserve to be here in the finals BUT I am in the belief that I have a stronger game than him and deserve your jury votes. I will show you in this speech why I deserve to win.

First of all, the **high points** of my game.

- My social game. This game I was only a final nominee once if you don't count f3 and I only received one vote against me the whole game despite being nominated 4 times. I had many connections throughout the game, some weaker than others, and my favourite part of my social game was having my conflicts be known by EVERYONE. Nobody had anything on me because I was honest with my goals and objectives to everyone who asked. I always had at least one active f2 deal open with feist, then an unofficial mutual agreement with me and Ryan, then Fred, then another unofficial with Zarfot just incase. It was a dooze vs myself from jury onwards which made it even better because I knew I could eventually get her out, and that once I did my safety up until this point was secured. I was able to secure deals very easily and I believe I was also able to make myself be saw as unthreatening despite me knowing how each week was going to pan out. Even though I wasn't able to nominate anyone, I definitely had my hand in the evictions and I really didn't get much of the blood onto my hands.
- My strategy. I always had the worst in mind and never prepared for the best. I'm a naturally competitive person so ofc I aimed for that gold. I don't have a problem doing what I must to get there. At jury I was allies with 6/8 of the players, my only enemies being dooze and deandean at that stage in the game. I was always able to adapt when things didn't go my way, for example qrstuv being evicted and me being the only vote against verumbark. Despite them winning HoH the very next week, I was able to keep myself from being up by identifying bigger threats for them to take out. I made sure I was telling them about baabaa to try and get her up over me by pledging my honesty to them because they had knew that I hadn't betrayed them despite voting them twice. Even when I went against people's plans, I still had really good links with the players in this game. For example, the Markus vs baabaa vote in f8, before the Fast Forward week. Throughout this week, I had thought I was winning it and was confident in my plans. This changed when I found out that Fred AND Dooze had higher scores than me and I had to change my game for that situation. That was the sole reason I went against the initial plan of voting Markus out, and it worked in my favour, as if I voted Markus out, I

would have been evicted over verumbark and over Zarfot both. It also worked in my favour because I ended up eliminating Fred's f2, which worked heavily in my favour as it was something in everyone's minds since they were nominated together during week 5. This freed up his f2 space for me to take it and since he was a challenge god I was able to use that to my advantage as even if people saw us as a f2, they would prioritise him over me.

The most notable example I have of this is within f6 when I had scenarios covered for every possible HoH winner and how I could turn it within my favour as shown.

f6 is actually when the game started to get into momentum for me. Dooze was unable to win HoH. deandean and I had begun talking again at this stage, thank goodness for that, and we had agreed on eliminating f2's. Of course, everyone knew dooze/Markus and Markus/Zarfot were things, although I only pushed primarily on dooze/Markus because I knew Zarfot would end up going against him eventually. Markus and Zarfot ended up being nommed together, lucky me since I was in an alliance w/ them both. I tried my hardest to win PoV although Fred ended up taking it, which was good for me personally as he was my f2 which I reckon no one really suspected. I was loyal af to it. Anyways, despite me wanting dooze up, Fred didn't use the PoV which still guaranteed me safety. We ended up voting Markus together which I was blessed af to do. Markus was a MASSIVE threat not only because of his f2 with dooze(which I never got if it was true or not? I'll assume it was for now but maybe you can clear that up?) but his game was superb. He had to go before he would sail to the end and win.

In f5 Zarfot was able to snag us the HoH win. I knew that he wanted Fred out and would have loved to use him as collateral damage. I was trusted by Fred and Zarfot and was on a lesser term trusted by deandean which put me in a very good position. My move this week was to leak my f2

with Fred to both Zarfot and deandean. I leaked it to Zarfot during his thinking of noms, making him put dooze/Fred up. Although it wasn't what I wanted, it was the best for my game and I definitely encouraged it because that way, if Fred won PoV he wouldn't use it on dooze and would be forced to use it on himself. I ended up being renominated due to Fred being saved by dean which I expected. It forced me to leak my F2 with Fred also to Dean because I thought it was influence his decision because fmpov, he was stuck because he had thought me and Zarfot were a f2(we kinda were, just unofficial) and Fred and Dooze were a f2. I pushed the idea onto him that Fred multi f2'd me with dooze, and emphasised my game as being a loner now at the revelation. It was tough because it ended up 1-1 and I still have no idea who voted me and who didn't because both claimed to so I sadly can't go into too much discussion on whether it was effective or not or if I'm just talking nonsense. Either way, I managed to live. Hooray.

In F4 I had managed to perfect a situation where all 3 would likely take me to f3 if they were the sole voter, however I didn't need it in the end because I won the PoV securing my safety. Now. The choice that I believe got me here. Zarfot vs deandean. Let me explain in detail why I chose to evict deandean to clear any confusion, because I understand that taking deandean was the 'right' move.

Firstly, I had to make sure f3 was filled with two people who would take me over the other. I knew Fred would take me over Zarfot and that Zarfot would take me over Fred. However, dean was very much a wildcard. If he won F3 HoH, then I could not guarantee that he would choose me over Fred because he admitted his game was goaty. I had thought in his case, he would have knew he would not win even if he won F3 HoH and took Fred anyway. I couldn't allow a scenario I couldn't predict to happen.

Secondly, this situation I'm in right now. Although I knew I could win against deandean, I believed I played a better game than Zarfot as well. From that perspective, there was no reason for me to take deandean over Zarfot because it wasn't a matter of who can I beat since I knew I could beat them both. If I took deandean, I'd be forced to win HoH to make f2 which as you can see I didn't. Even if I won HoH, I'd still be evicting Fred either way which he did play the best game out of all of us.

Thirdly, my satisfaction as a loyal player to my deals. I stayed true to myself in my decision knowing the consequences because sure, dean would be annoyed, but so would Zarfot and I would probably lose his vote as well. Both were quite literally the same in what they would do and what they could offer, so I had to base it on granting myself access to the f2 no matter what. I did not play for 2nd. I played for AT LEAST 2nd so that I could be here explaining my game and proving that I deserve to win this game.

I also didn't need to rely on challenge wins to keep me here because my social game did that for me. The challenges I won were merely a bonus for my draft.

## My low points

My biggest low point this game I would say is that I really didn't admittedly do MUCH. I wasn't really the big move maker of this game even though I'd plotted moves, I wasn't able to carry them out myself and I did rely on others to do it for me. Although necessarily I don't think it is a bad thing personally, I was able to get people to carry out my plans and keep myself a non threat by letting others get targeted for things such as challenge wins etc. I was keeping a very low profile which although I don't regret, I could have been much more high profile and I think that was the toughest thing I was struggling with.

Another low point of mine was focussing too much on dooze in the jury stages of the game. I realise looking back that I was a cunt LMAO. I tunnel visioned her af and even though I can't have full regrets as I believe it partly got me here, I have a regret that I didn't pay much attention to the game AROUND her. I partly just lost focus because I needed to get the people out who would want me gone and not keep me around, and she was one of them. My mind was clouded by getting revenge for my fallen allies which sounds really cheesy but it's true LOL.

My jury management could have been WAY better. I made more enemies than I would have liked and because of my bonds, I was always having to make decisions to vote allies out which may have angered some of you. I hope ya'll aren't bitter bc I had to do it fhhfhfg. I was aiming for the 50 bucks!

Another personal lowpoint of mine is my early game. I think I made too many mistakes in leaving myself wide open to be voted because even when I knew the Clusterfuck had been leaked, I still put my trust in it and I don't think I should have. I should have started hunting for new allies much sooner so that I could be sure of my safety. Because that's really all my early game was, the Clusterfuck and short conversations with people because I wasn't winning anything. My early game really just consisted of small talk to almost everyone, making sure everyone enjoyed me in the house chat because that always has an impact on people outside of the house chat and getting by without making enemies for the most part. I needed to make sure people wanted to work with me. Luckily because of this I found myself many allies and I was able to use it into my favour. I always made sure to throw people under the bus to HoH's whenever possible however, most commonly putting the Survivor group up as ideas yet still being honest with who I was close to. No one likes liars in the early game and I needed to put myself out there as someone to trust in the long run and not to be dumped early.

## What I believe to have accomplished this game

I believe I have accomplished my goal of reaching the final 2 staying true to myself. I don't need to be fake to people to have a shot of winning this game. I'd rather come 2nd(lol jk) staying true to myself than win and be fake about it. I was honest and open and when I could be honest, I was honest. There's zero point playing a fake af game.

I also believe I was a part in getting the big threats of Markus/dooze out when they did. I was able to convince Zarfot that we needed to get them out asap, and I was able to flip a vote of dean/Fred onto dooze and got her out via that. I don't believe I need to win the HoH in order to be a part in getting them out, or have big massive plans against them, it just took simple conversation in convincing others to sway their votes. I was able to prove those 2 were close, and tbh! I think I had a pretty convincing case of dean/baabaa/dooze working together even if they weren't together as a WHOLE.

I was able to play the other contestants in achieving my goals for me and saving me when I needed it to happen. E.g verumbark putting baabaa up instead of me, saving Markus so he could use PoV on me the very next week. I believe I was able to formulate a good plan for my game at the late stages of this game which allowed me to get to this position I'm in now.

I was able to secure myself very trusting allies and was able to prove myself as a trustworthy individual in this game. Myself offering to be pawned only proved this trust and I think that was why people were so nice w/ me in the game because I was just a happy person and people wanted to work with me! That's why when f6 came, I was in an alliance with 2 of the other 5 players, I had a f2 with one other, one I had previous feuds with but we were working together to rid of f2's and then my sworn enemy. I always had some form of safety whether it was my lucky PoV wins when they came to me or my alliances.

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Ummmm tbh LIKE idk what to say anymore. I guess to conclude after explaining my high points and low points and what I've accomplished during this journey, that's why I think I deserve to win over Zarfot because I don't think he can say the same for what I've said. I don't really like the whole vagueness of the "why should I win" be there is so much hella irrelevant stuff that no one wants to hear so like if you have any questions about my game that I haven't explained or you need further clarification then im happy to answer! I prefer being able to answer specifics as opposed to vague broadness! I hope at least you all understand where I'm coming from in what I've talked about because I genuinely do think I've played a better game than Zarfot. I don't think I was as much of a floater and I don't think I was dragged around in this game. But yeah Idk how to write a speech or do this shit so I hope this does fine?
