You had to practice. You should have rehearsed what you were going to say before the presentation. You could have rehearsed at home, or you might have practiced with your friends.

For next time, you must practice more. You should remember all the words before the presentation. You could also try speaking louder. You had better use clear text and diagrams for your slides. And whatever you do, make sure you turn your phone off before the presentation.

You might want to think more about your body language. If I were you, I would use gestures and smile more when I'm in front of the class.

Have you thought about wearing formal clothes? You ought to look nice when you're doing a presentation. And why don't you give an outline to your audience, so that they can follow along with you. And whatever you do, don't turn your back to your audience.
