What is the SNEE?

The SNEE (Statut National d'Étudiant-Entrepreneur — National Student-Entrepreneur Status) is an official status granted by the SEL-RULE to students pursuing higher education while developing a creative idea or entrepreneurial project.

The SNEE supports students engaged in all forms of entrepreneurial activity: business creation, associative projects, major event organisation, or intrapreneurship within existing structures; regardless of whether the goal is economic, social, cultural, or ecological.

It is managed by the Sustainable Entrepreneurship Lab (SEL-RULE).

By obtaining the SNEE, you benefit from:

- **Official recognition:** Your project is recognized as an integral part of your academic journey. A signed certificate is issued by URDSE.
- **Ecosystem access:** Events, expert talks, networking with partners of the SEL-RULE and the French cooperation ecosystem.
- **Incubation pathway:** Possibility to apply to the Sustainable Entrepreneurship Incubator Program (levels 2 & 3).

The SNEE is awarded at one of three levels based on the maturity of your project at the time of application. Read each level carefully before selecting the one that best describes your current situation.

Level 1: Student at the Beginning of an Entrepreneurial Journey

You have a clear business idea and have started or completed basic entrepreneurship training.

Required justifications:

- Written description of your project idea (concept, problem addressed, target audience)
- Short motivation letter (why you want the SNEE and what you aim to achieve)
- Evidence of entrepreneurship training or course attended (certificate, transcript, or enrolment confirmation) - optional



Level 2: Student with an Innovative Project/Venture

You have a functional prototype or service integrating innovative technological or digital dimensions, and you have conducted a market study.

Required justifications:

- Prototype or functional demo (link, file, or description with screenshots/visuals)
- Market study or market research document
- Evidence of entrepreneurship training or course attended
- Short motivation letter describing the innovative dimension of your project and your development roadmap

Level 3: Student with an Established Business

You have already launched an effective commercial activity on the market.

Required justifications:

- Proof of business registration (patent, business license, MoC registration, or equivalent)
- Evidence of commercial activity: invoices, contracts, client references, revenue statement, or similar
- Brief presentation of current business operations and future development objectives
- Short motivation letter explaining how the SNEE will support the next stage of your venture
