Slide Presentation: N Rose provided a slide presentation of an overview of Yosemite High School, including the Mission Statement (F.I.R.E.) and Vision. Additionally, the presentation included data (YHS Student Profile Snapshot), LCAP Services/Resources (staff serves both YHS and SHS), and Grade Marks and rewards eligibility information (for Dynamite Dragons, field trips, certificates, and lunch rewards). K Boykin reported students have asked their attendance be corrected in order to qualify for incentives.

The campus underwent a beautification over the summer, which included updated logo and banners placed in the Admin Bldg quad, rocks and plants in the planters and a marquee placed on the building in front of the school. Parent outreach has improved

through Parent Square calls, Instagram and with the hiring of the YHS Community/School Resource Liaison. The Liaison has made parent calls to inform of school events. C Conley (the parent in attendance) reported following YHS on Instagram and mentioned hearing of the taco truck student incentive for students with a 3.0 GPA or higher.

N Rose reported Summer School was provided as Project-Based Learning where late graduate students earned their diploma. YHS students had the option of attending Summer School at YHS or online through MHS. C Conley reported her son enjoyed the Summer School program overall.

N Rose reviewed the LCAP Goals, including what activities YHS is doing under each Goal, staffing services, and staff training requirements (in-person and online).

YHS Title I and Budget: N Rose reported the Title I budget is more restrictive this year. The LCAP Equity Funds is the majority of the school's funding; however, at this time, there are no details on what is and what is not allowed for spending. Our District Business Office monitors what is being spent and will make funding changes if the expense is not allowed.

CSI Funding: N Rose reported the ELA and Math test scores were very low last year and the need to address students who do not take the test seriously. CSI Funds in the amount of \$170,00 has been provided to address improving the test scores. C Conley suggested providing an incentive for students taking the tests.

Ideas to Engage Students: C Conley reported her son is very interested in working on his resume to get a job. She also asked about volunteering opportunities students can include on their resumes. N Rose reported the English and Career Technical Education (CTE) teachers assist students with building their resumes. Many of the jobs today require an online application process. N Rose reported on Career Day being held on November 17. The focus is on Seniors; however, all YHS students participate. C Conley asked about field trips for students, such as to a theater to watch a play or for students who are interested in working in theater. D Amador reported on the upcoming field trip to the Merced County Fairgrounds for the Merced County Office of Education (MCOE) Career Industry Day on October 19. This is a good opportunity for students to see what types of careers are available for them. C Conley asked if YHS has school dances. N Rose reported that Prom is held at YHS in May. YHS students can ask permission to attend dances at the comprehensive sites. YHS holds athletic tournaments throughout the year (Volleyball, Dodgeball, Basketball and Soccer).
