2. Yachting NZ Affiliated Club.

If you are currently not a member of a Yacht Club affiliated with Yachting NZ (e.g. QCYC or Waikawa BC)

Queen Charlotte Yacht Club (QCYC) offer a restricted youth membership costing \$45. This covers your affiliation fee to Yachting NZ and use of the club facilities on training days (showers, changing rooms) and a small administration cost. You can purchase this membership by going on the Queen Charlotte Yacht Club Website www.qcyc.org.nz.

1. Click on the "JOIN QCYC" button on the left hand side of the page
2. Click on the Join QCYC/ Learn to Sail Course
3. This will bring you to a sailor registration page. Fill in the details and under "yacht type" select 420
4. Once you have registered you will be offered choices of membership on the next "page" **Select RESTRICTED YOUTH MEMBERSHIP**

2. Insurance Levy

Sailors who attend independent schools or are home schooled will be required to pay an additional \$30 insurance levy to cover the costs of insurance on the 420 Yachts

Currently, MBC, MGC and QCC pay a contribution to the insurance of the 420 yacht's on behalf of their students. (Students transitioning to these schools would be covered by this). This levy is to ensure a fair contribution by all.
