How To Apply:

- (1) Application
 - o Complete the fill in the blank cover letter and resume' provided below.
 - o Already have a cover letter and/or resume'? Great! Use that one.
 - O Young applicants may not have information to put into all resume' topic area and that is OK! Some sections may be left blank others may have one item. It is OK!
- (2) Active 4-H Enrollment is required. Do this in mn.4Honline.com
- (3) Please complete the Isanti County Program Guideline signed by yourself and a parent/guardian (see below)
- (4) Email rostx034@umn.edu or mail cover letter, resume', and program guideline to Isanti County Extension Office, 555 18th Ave Sw, Cambridge, MN 55008 all applications must be received by Friday, October 18, 2024!

Helpful Hints:

Cover Letter:

- O The purpose of a cover letter is to tell the reader why your application should be considered and provide information to the reader about you that they may miss in the resume'
- o Use appropriate grammar and punctuation.
- o Cover letters are short, descriptive, and concise
- O Your cover letter should include what you are applying for and how your experience will benefit the program. Examples: leadership opportunities, service learning projects etc.. Fill in the blank format is below. Feel free to edit it as you wish! <u>Again if you have a</u> <u>current cover letter already please use that one – no need to duplicate efforts!</u>
- o Make sure replace the highlighted areas with your information if you use this template

Resume':

- Your resume' should include pertinent information and be used to build a resource for your future use.
- o Include work experience, volunteer experience, leadership experience, education, special accomplishments, and other interests. Be specific and include dates.
- o Include each section on your resume' even if you do not have anything to put in it yet. Again this is a work in progress and each year you will be updating this information.
- o Leave a section blank if you have nothing to add. This is a work in progress and blank spaces are expected and OK!
- o Resume' should be one page. Your resume' will be unique to you.
- o <u>If you already have a updated resume' please use that one.</u> **No need to duplicate** <u>efforts.</u>

Why Become a 4-H Ambassador:

- Develop talents and interests as youth leaders
- Cultivate leadership communication, teamwork, and decision-making skills
- Provide opportunities to participate in service learning projects and citizenship
- Strengthen and promote 4-H in Isanti County.
- Have a voice in what happens in Isanti County 4-H

Program Term:

- Application opens September October for young people grades 7-13
- Program runs October September
- Selection process is open for all youth who agree to program expectations and guidelines.

Program Expectations and Guidelines:

- Attendance-The following three items are required
 - Attend 7 Ambassador meetings (Meeting days may change)
 - Assist with an Ambassador Fundraiser
 - Give a demonstration/project talk at a group event (BBOP, Project Workshop Day, Club meeting, Council meeting, Ambassador meeting, Project meeting)
- General County Activities (<u>Complete at least three</u>)
 - Serve on at least 1 County Committee (Auction, Animal Science, CFC etc)
 - Serve on the 4-H Council
 - Attend/Lead Leadership Training
 - Attend/ Lead Officer Training
 - Attend 4-H Council Meeting(s)- at least 3
- County Fair (<u>Complete at least four</u>)
 - Help with Fair set up before fair
 - Help with setting up projects in the 4-H Exhibit Building at the fair
 - Help to set up a barn
 - Help with pre-fair set up of the Clover Family Café
 - Help at the County Fair- Checklist comes at June meeting- REQUIRED
- General (Complete at least five)
 - Serve as camp counselor
 - Lead a class for Project Workshop Days
 - Help teach a day camp
 - Create 2 Project Demonstration Videos
 - Emcee at Share the Fun
 - Help at AG Day at Culvers if it happens every year
 - Serve as a State Ambassador
 - Help at Breakfast on the Farm
 - Share Ambassador experience with your club or a project group
- 4-H Code of Conduct: will be followed.



Meetings:

- o Meetings are scheduled by current ambassador advisors and ambassadors.
- o Meetings or an event will be held monthly
- o Inability to attend a meeting/event: Call the person in charge of the scheduled event to notify that person you are not able to come.
- o You will find a couple months with more than one activity usually February and July.

• "Uniform":

- o Wear a 4-H t-shirt at 4-H sponsored events. The group will decide on ordering an ambassador shirt.
- o Wear your Isanti County 4-H Ambassador Name tag at sponsored events.
