Did you know? In 2023, less than 15% of Needham registered voters cast a ballot in the local election! We need your civic spirit and creativity to help increase voter turnout. Needham League of Women Voters is encouraging individuals, families, neighborhoods, and local organizations to create and display your own "Get Out and Vote" lawn signs.

Guidelines for signs:

- Must be reusable
- Indicate Election date (April 9) or Second Tuesday in April
- Readable from a distance
- Recyclable/reused material
- Display on lawn by March 18th

For example, Town officials will be proposing some zoning changes related to the MBTA Communities Act this year for Town Meeting approval. They also impact how our tax dollars are spent. As registered voters, it is important that individual voices be heard through the election process.
